Worship

Verb: Show reverence and adoration for (a deity); honor with religious rites.

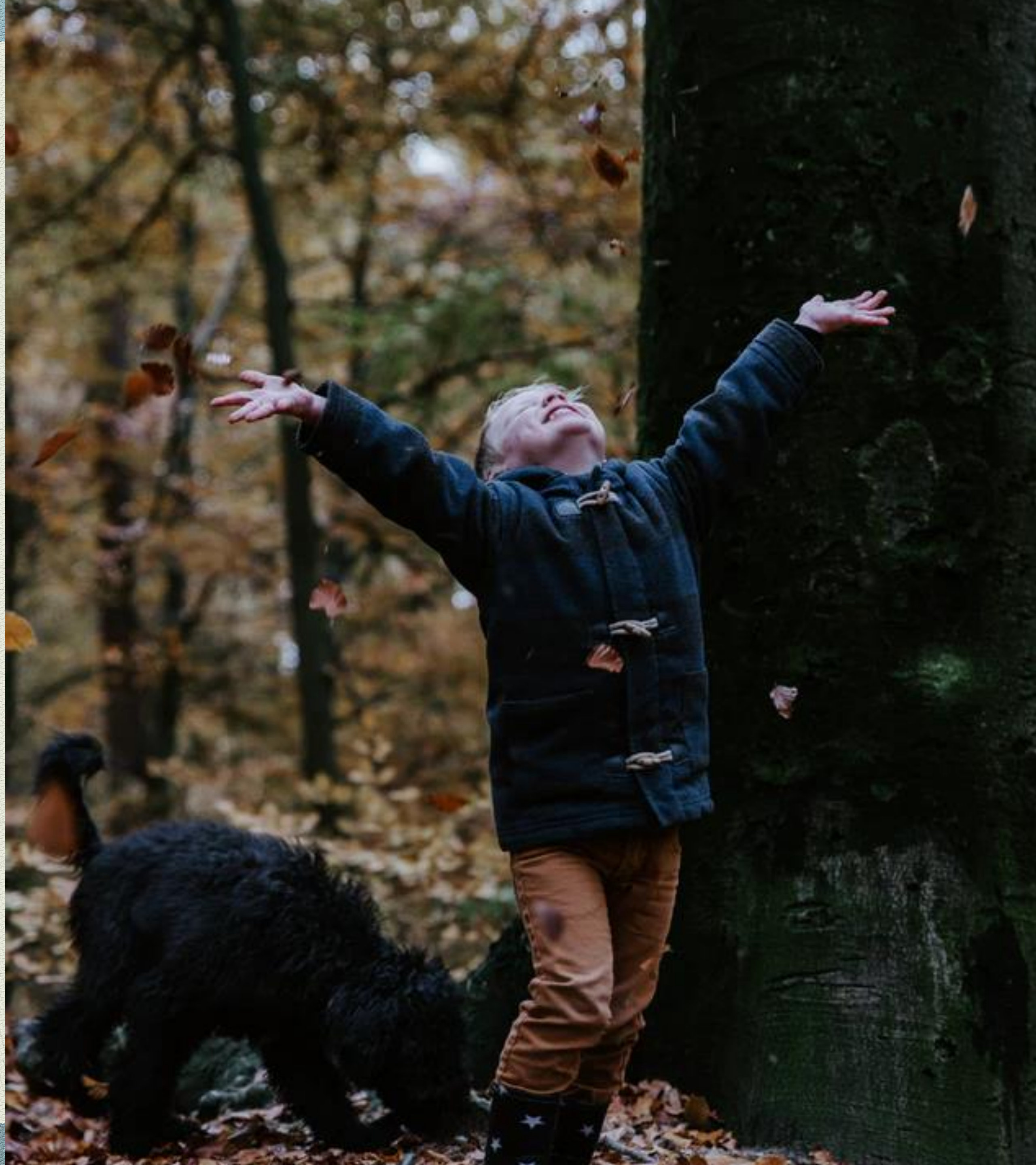
Noun: The feeling or expression of reverence and adoration for a deity.

Praise

Verb: Express warm approval or admiration of.

Noun: The expression of approval or admiration for someone or something.

Psalm 29:1-2

Modern English version: 1 Give to the Lord, you heavenly beings, give to the Lord glory and strength. 2 Give to the Lord the glory of His name; worship the Lord in holy splendor.

NIV: 1 Ascribe to the Lord, you heavenly beings, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength. 2 Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness.

Psalm 100:1-2

Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth.

Worship the Lord with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs.

Psalm 105:1-6

1 Praise the Lord. Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens.

2 Praise him for his acts of power; praise him for his surpassing greatness.

Psalm 105:1-6 (cont'd)

3 Praise him with the sounding of the trumpet, praise him with the harp and lyre,

4 praise him with timbrel and dancing; praise him with the strings and pipe,

Psalm 105:1-6 (cont'd)

5 praise him with the clash of cymbals; praise him with resounding cymbals.

6 Let everything that has breath praise the Lord. Praise the Lord.



Ephesians 5:18-20

18 Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit, 19 speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit.

Ephesians 5:18-20 (cont'd)

Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord, 20 always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Colossians 3:16

Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

Hebrews 13:15

Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.
